FROM THE PASTOR

In Philippians 1:3-5, the Apostle Paul wrote, “I give thanks to my God for every remembrance of you, always praying with joy for all of you in my every prayer, because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now...” Paul wrote of his love for his brothers and sisters in Christ and how he prayed for them with “joy.” Even as he wrote of giving thanks and praying with joy, we are reminded that Paul was in prison when he wrote these words. Two principles stand out for us to consider:

The first is the idea of **praying for one another**. We will put this principle to the test over the next few months. Our church is going to enter into a time of praying for one another that I hope proves to be both intense and effective. Each family will receive, in the mail, a prayer assignment. This assignment will include two or three families that you will be asked to pray for. We will also ask that you contact your families regularly to see if there are any prayer needs or what ways that our church can be ministering to them.

The second principle that stands out, is the idea that **our “joy” does not come from our circumstances**. Happiness depends upon what happens, but joy is something that abides deep within our spirit when Jesus lives within us. Happiness comes and goes with our everchanging situations. But our joy is always there even when things don’t go the way we planned. Joy is not dependent upon outward stimulus because Jesus never leaves us nor forsakes us.

So, in the coming days, look for opportunities to pray for each other and turn to Jesus daily that our Joy may abound.
