For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39)

This passage reminds us that, in Christ, nothing will separate us from the love of God. That includes pandemics, rioting, political pandering, and the fear that is gripping the world around us. So if this is true, how should we respond? 1) Repent: if you do not know Jesus as Lord and Savior, then turn from sin that separates you from him and ask forgiveness to become His. If you know Him as Lord, then seek forgiveness that you may walk with Him in a closer relationship. 2) Pray: Seek God's Wisdom, Guidance and Peace. Pray often and pray fervently. 3) Study His Word: Don't just read it; learn it. 4) Obey Him: If you truly love Him then keep His commands. He loves you, and you cannot go wrong following Him. 5) Be: be the person that He has created you to be.

As you let God transform your life, He will use you to transform the world around you.
